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This letter is in response to the Commission request for additional information, dated May 18, 2005, regarding the Committee's Year End Report for 2004.

The Committee is currently undergoing an internal audit of all activity for the 2004 calendar year. As part of this audit the Committee has converted all financial data to NGP Software. However, the data conversion for the Year End Report has not yet been completed. As a result, the Committee is unable to file an amended report for this period at this time. We will soon file omnibus amendments to this and other reports as soon as possible. These amendments will address, inter alia, the matters raised concerning MEMO Entries for Dollars for Democrats, incorrect allocation ratios for administrative activities, missing addresses for disbursements on Schedule B for Lines 21(b) and 30(b), clarification for purposes on disbursements, and obligations on Schedule D. We are able however, to answer some issues listed in the Commission's Letter of May 18, 2005 below.

Schedule A supporting Line 17 shows receipts from Feaster Inc. and Landmark Strategies Inc. These receipts were incorrectly reported on Line 17. These receipts were offsets to operating expenditures, and should have been reported on Line 15. Subsequent amendments to the Year End Report will reflect this correction.

The Committee has disclosed all disbursements for administrative activities. Although some may reflect incorrect allocation ratios for this cycle, this will be corrected in subsequent amendments for the period. Under no circumstance has the Committee accepted in-kinds for administrative activities, or has the Committee used non-federal funds for allocable administrative expenditures.

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
