Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses an offset to an operating expenditure(s) totaling \$925.97 from "Automatic Data Processing" for "Refund – Insurance"; however, your report(s) does not appear to disclose a disbursement to this entity for this purpose. Please provide clarifying information regarding this activity and amend your report(s) if necessary.
2. Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses an offset to an operating expenditure(s) totaling \$10,649.86 from "Meridian Imaging Solutions," "The Freedom Project" and "Theodore Clark"; however, your report(s) does not appear to disclose a disbursement to this entity. Please provide clarifying information regarding this activity and amend your report(s) if necessary.
3. Schedule B supporting Line 28(a) discloses a refund on 4/9/10 of \$500 for a contribution received from Edward Chastka. On Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of this report, you disclose a negative entry of \$500 that was charged back to Edward Chastka. However, this individual appears to only have contributed a total of \$500 to your committee. Please amend the appropriate report(s) to clarify this discrepancy as well as to


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disclose the original date of the contribution(s) on Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
