Dear Ms. Miller:

This letter is in response to the Commission's request for additional information related to the dates of forwarded earmarks on Schedule B that precede the dates of the receipts on Schedule A and the untimely forwarding of earmarked contributions on the above referenced report filed by JSTREETPAC.

The Commission has asked about \$6,322.50 in earmarked contributions for which the dates of the forwarded earmarks on Schedule B are preceding the dates of the receipt on Schedule A. The committee has reviewed its records for the reporting period and discovered that a data entry error in the committee's accounting software led to an incorrect disbursement date that was used for these earmarked contributions. An amended Post-General Report has been filed to correct the date of these disbursements.

Additionally, the Commission has asked about \$3,529 in earmarked contributions not forwarded on to the authorized committee within 10 days after receiving them. The committee fully understands and complies with the regulation requiring earmarked contributions to be forwarded on within 10 days. The specific contributions referenced above were initially forwarded on by JStreetPAC within the permissible time period; however, the checks were never received by the authorized committee. In order to ensure the contributions were received, JStreetPAC voided the original disbursement checks and re-issued them to the authorized committee for which they were earmarked. As the Commission provides very little guidance on the handling of earmarked contributions that need to be voided, the committee believes it has complied with the law.
