To Whom It May Concern:

We are in receipt of the Commission's letter regarding the above referenced report, thank you for the opportunity to respond. Please see below for our complete response.

We are keenly aware of the contribution limits set forth in the Act and we very conscientiously monitor the contribution total of our donors. You bring three specific donors to our attention and after reviewing our records; there is a simple explanation for each. To be clear, none are excessive donors.

There are actually 2 Donald Leeberns; Jr. and the III. The problem arises from the fields the FEC report pulls from our software. The distinction is made in our program, but not reflected on the report. Upon receiving your letter, this problem was corrected. To clarify, Donald Leebern Jr. contributed \$2000 to the Primary 2006 election and \$2000 to the General 2006 election on 2-11-05. Donald Leebern III contributed \$2000 to the Primary 2006 election and \$2000 to the General 2006 election on 2-18-05.

The AFLAC, Inc. PAC has not exceeded its limits either. The three contributions in questions are designated as follows. The 12-31-04 \$3000 contribution was for Run-Off 2004 debt. The 2-18-05 \$8000 contribution was designated \$3000 to Primary 2004 debt and \$5000 to the Primary 2006.

Our committee accepted \$2000 for both the 2004 Primary and 2004 Run-Off elections from Congressman Nathan Deal's campaign. The refund in question is for \$1000 for each of those contributions. As you are aware the limit last cycle was only \$1000 per election. The disbursement is reflected as a Primary 2006 disbursement because that is the period in which it was made.

We also accepted \$2000 for the 2004 Primary from Friends of Bobby Jindal. As in the above situation, the refund is reported as a 2006 disbursement since it was made during this period.
