Re: Designation of Contribution

The Michigan Credit Union League Legislative Action Fund (MCULLAF) has been notified by the Federal Election Commission that it made an excessive contribution to your committee for the 2000 primary election. MCULLAF is affiliated with the Credit Union Legislative Action Council of CUNA (CULAC) and as such the contributions of these PACs are aggregated for FEC campaign contribution limits. FEC reports indicate that MCULLAF and CULAC contributed a combined \$10,000 for the primary election, \$5,000 over the maximum allowed by law.

This letter is to inform you that MCULLAF will remedy this situation by redesignating the excessive contribution of \$5,000 to the 2000 general election. This will be reported as a memo entry on an amended FEC report.

On August 2, 2000, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your August 11, 2000 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-You indicate on Schedule B supporting Line 23 that you have redesignated the contribution to Rogers For Congress dated March 29, 2000. Please provide the date on which you authorized, in writing, the redesignation of this contribution to the general election.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by September 13, 2000. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
