

The following is text from a letter dated November 5, 2007 provided to Sylvette Seay, Campaign Finance Analyst, in response to an FEC letter dated September 21, 2007.

Dear Ms. Seay:

I am writing in response to your letter of September 21, 2007, to the Verizon Communications Inc. Good Government Club ("Verizon PAC"), which advised that paper documents submitted to the FEC dated August 22, 2007, were not an acceptable response to the July 25, 2007, letter regarding the 2006 Amended July Quarterly Report. It stated that all responses need to be filed electronically.

The amendment for the 2006 July Quarterly report that was requested in the July 25, 2007, letter was filed electronically, and on time. We had, nonetheless, prepared a written explanation to accompany the amendment. We provided a paper copy of the explanation as a courtesy and had intended to file an electronic copy on Form 99. We have since learned that our PAC vendor loaded the Form 99 for the 2006 Amended April Quarterly report, which was filed at the same time, twice, and did not load the Form 99 for the 2006 Amended July Quarterly Report at all. Accordingly, we instructed our vendor to load the correct Form 99 file for the 2006 July Report. You may view this document by going to the Campaign Finance Reports and Data>View/Download Electronic Filings section, searching for our committee, and viewing the Form 99 dated October 1, 2007. I note that the Form 99 was not required by the July 25, 2007, letter and that the amended report that was required was filed on time and in the proper electronic format.

When we spoke about this matter on the telephone, you also indicated concern about whether the paper documents submitted by the Verizon PAC were an acceptable filing. I wanted to make it clear that the paper documents submitted by the Verizon PAC on August 22, 2007, were: (1) a letter sent in response to the FEC's request for information dated July 25, 2007; and (2) a copy of the FEC letter dated July 25, 2007; and were intended solely as courtesy copies. These documents have been scanned by the FEC, and can be found on the FEC website under the heading "Miscellaneous Report to FEC" dated August 22, 2007. The text of the Verizon PAC's letter was included in its entirety in the Form 99 that was submitted by the Verizon PAC as described above.
