Your June 17, 2003 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Your Miscellaneous Electronic Document response dated 6/17/03 indicates that corrective action has been taken regarding the DE 1002 fundraising program or event disclosed on Schedule H2. This response states the, "the date has been added to the event DE 1002 10/22/02." However, a Schedule H2 disclosing your correction action has been omitted from your amended report filed on 6/17/03. Please be advised that a Schedule H2 should be filed disclosing the date of the fundraising program or event that the allocation ratio for DE 1002 was revised during the reporting period. Please amend this report in order to enclose the omitted Schedule H2.

-Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why the disbursements were made. Please amend Schedule(s) H4 of your report to clarify the following description(s): "office supplies." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursements, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by July 16, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
