

Mr. Gibson,

This correspondence is in response to the Commission's request for additional information regarding the above referenced reports.

The Commission has requested clarification for disbursements reported on Schedule B that indicates a transfer from our federal to non-federal accounts. These transfers were made to accurately reflect the federal/non-federal expenditure split our committee had adopted for previous and current election cycles. These dollars were not used to influence the election or defeat of a particular federal candidate. These funds were ultimately disbursed as non-federal funds to the non-federal account of the South Dakota Democratic Party.

An amendment to our Post-General report correcting mathematical errors will follow this response.
