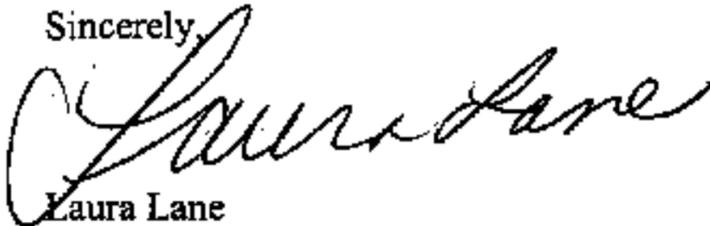

Dear Ms. DeCarmine,

In reference to your letters dated March 8, 2006 and March 15, 2006, the errors on the monthly reports listed above originated because of a problem that occurred when entering our amended information into the software that we use to generate our compliance reports. Only the reporting period total for line 8 was automatically updated to reflect the voided \$2,000 contribution to Friends of Harry Reid on May 6, 2005 and the updated \$5,000 contribution to Friends of Hillary on August 4, 2006, leaving the previous amount in the year-to-date column and offsetting subsequent cash on hand totals.

To reconcile this issue, we have manually entered the 'year to date' total so as to reflect the new amount and be consistent with the rest of line 8. We will now file the amended compliance reports for those listed above as well as the February Monthly Report which was also affected by this miscalculation. Additionally, we have contacted the software company that generates our monthly reports and notified them that this aspect of their program can lead to reporting problems. As always, we will continue to make every effort to ensure that our reporting is completely accurate and straightforward.
