Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following 2 items:

1. On Schedule B, Lines 23 and 28(a) of your report, you have itemized negative entries with the notation "prior period void." These appear to offset refunds that were made regarding 2008 primary expenditures and 2008 general election contributions. Please be advised that voided refund checks that are not re-issued for general election contributions may constitute excessive and/or prohibited contributions being retained by the committee. (2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(a) and (f); 11 CFR §§ 110.1(b), (e), and (k))

Any subsequent report(s) filed with the Commission must disclose the refund or redesignation of any general election contribution. Refunds or redesignations must be done within sixty days after the 2008 primary convention. (11 CFR § 103.3(b)(3)) Please take and report corrective action or amend your report if these transactions were incompletely or incorrectly disclosed.

2. Your report contains incorrect Column B figures for Lines 17(b), 17(c), 20(a), 20(d), 21, 22, 23, 28(a), 28(c), 28(d), and 30 of the Summary and Detailed Summary Page information. When aggregating and reporting receipts and disbursements, candidate committees are required to disclose their activity on an election-cycle basis, from 11/5/08 to 11/6/12. Please

amend your report to show election cycle-to-date figures for all aggregate amounts. (2 U.S.C. § 434(b))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
