Your July 10, 2000 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Please provide the date(s) on which you notified Doug Ose for Congress, Royce Campaign Committee, Bill Thomas Campaign Committee and Don Sherwood for Congress, in writing, of the redesignation of each contribution to the 2000 General Election.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by August 9, 2000. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
