This submission responds to the Commission letters regarding the committee s 2004 Post-General and Year-End reports. Please note that the committee is in the process of auditing these two reports and a comprehensive amendment to these two reports will be filed shortly. The transfers from the Boswell for Congress Committee have been clarified to more clearly identify for the public record the total amount received from this Committee. Schedule D has been amended to correctly reflect the debt to the Iowa Democratic Party Non-Federal Account. Receipts originally disclosed as Individual and Unitemized have been moved to Schedule A for Line 11(a)(ii). These contributions were from individuals who did not give more than \$200 in the calendar year. Please note that, as a result of its best efforts, an amendment has been filed that includes additional employer and occupation and address information obtained by the Committee since the original filing. During the 2004 cycle, the Committee established separate bank accounts for its receipts from National Party Committees; these funds were segregated from other federal funds and not used for exempt activities. Please note that an amended report has been filed to clarify purpose fields and include additional addresses. Unless otherwise noted, payments on Schedule B for Lines 21(b) and 30(b) did not refer to any specific candidate for federal office. Payments for Federal fundraising on Schedule B for Line 21(b) were not for any specific candidate for federal office. All payments for administrative expenses have been reported on a Schedule H4. The Committee did not make allocable expenditures from their non-federal account nor did they accept in-kinds for allocable expenditures. Receipts from Feaster Inc and Landmark Strategies Inc are for list purchases. The prices paid to the Committee for the lists are determined by the vendor as the fair market value for the purchases. The Committee believes that this price properly reflects the fair market value of the file, which represents the normal charge for such data in our state. The amount received by the Committee from Dollars for Democrats reflects proceeds from earlier reporting periods where the itemized MEMO entries were included on previous reports. Schedule D has been amended to correctly reflect the debt to the Iowa Democratic Party Non-Federal Account. All payments for administrative expenses have been reported on a Schedule H4. The Committee did not make allocable expenditures from their non-federal account nor did they accept in-kinds for allocable expenditures.
