-Political committees which have cash on hand at the time of registration must disclose the source of the funds. The balance is assumed to be composed of those contributions most recently received by the committee prior to registration. Please identify the source of these contributions on a mamo Schedule A. 11 CFR \$104.12

limited payments report discloses -Your administrative expenses. Administrative expenses are payments made for the purpose of operating a political committee including, but not limited to, rent, utilities, salaries, telephone service, office equipment and supplies. Any such payments to a person aggregating in excess of \$200 in a calendar year must be disclosed on Schedula H4, supporting Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page, 2 U.S.C. \$434(b)(5) If these expenses are being paid by a connected organization, your Statement of Organization must be amended to reflect this relationship. 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) In addition, if expenses have been incurred but not paid in a reporting period, the activity should be disclosed as a debt on Schedule D, if the obligation is \$500 or more, or outstanding for sixty days or more. 11 CFR \$104.11

Any goods or services provided to your committee by a person, except volunteer activity (i.e., a person's time), would be considered an in-kind contribution from that person, and would be subject to the disclosure

requirements of 2 U.S.C. \$434(b)(3) and 11 CFR \$104.13, and the limitations and prohibitions of 2 U.S.C. \$5441a and 441b.

Clarification regarding administrative expenses should be disclosed during each two year election cycle beginning with the first report filed in the nonelection year. Please provide the necessary information regarding administrative expenses incurred by your committee and/or emend your report to disclose such expenses according to the referenced provisions of the Act and Commission Regulations.

-Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses joint federal/non-federal operating expanditures during the period. Committees must itemixe reporting allocated disbursement made from its federal account or separate allocation account regardless of the amount. Please emend your raport(a) by itemizing the expenditures on Schedule H4. 11 CFR \$104.10

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
