On March 3, 1999, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your March 19, 1999, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Please amend your report by providing the purpose for each disbursement itemized on Schedule B supporting Line 21(b).

-Your response states that you have redesignated the \$1500 excessive contribution, made to the Moore for Congress Committee, to the campaign's 1998 Primary Election debt. The excessive contribution was made on October 29, 1998; however, the Moore for Congress Committee had no debt from 1/1/98 through 11/23/98. Therefore, the campaign had no debt to retire at the time of your contribution. You still need to correct this excessive contribution by requesting a refund of \$1500, or, redesignating the amount to a future election. Please inform the Commission of the corrective action (including dates) taken. You may provide a photocopy of the refund request or written redesignation in response to this letter.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
