The committee is responding to your letter of May 10, 2000 concerning our 7/1/99-12/31/99 report.

Your letter indicates that the committee has reported limited administrative expenses. I personally handle virtually all of the "back office" administrative tasks on a volunteer basis. This includes all bill paying, miscellaneous correspondence, preparing and filing the FEC report, and other functions as needed. I perform these services on a computer in my personal residence. We have no other office location, no rent, no utilities (other than telephone, which has been reported), and no salaries of any kind. An outside consulting firm, being paid on a percentage basis of funds raised has handled the bulk of our fundraising efforts.
