This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:


1. Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses an offset to an operating expenditure(s) totaling \$34,161.43 from "Walter Karl - A Donnelly Marketing Company"; however, your report(s) does not appear to disclose a disbursement to this entity. Please provide clarifying information regarding this activity and amend your report(s) if necessary.
2. -Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses an offset to an operating expenditure(s) totaling \$2,662.40 from "Conexis"; however, there are \$2,062.63 in disbursements to this entity disclosed on your disbursement schedule(s). Please provide clarifying information regarding this discrepancy and amend your report(s) if necessary.
3. Please clarify all expenditures made for "Catering Food & Beverage", "Design/Printing", "Events-Meetings Venue Rental Fee", "Receptn-Venue/Tents" and "Telemarketing Services" on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B, E or F supporting Lines 23, 24 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
