Dear Mr. Davis:

On February 4, of this year the NJDC PAC filed its Notification of Multicandidate Status, notifying the Federal Election Commission that it qualified as a multicandidate PAC on August 16, 1996.

As you know, several candidates that the PAC made contributions to since August 16, 1996, have received notices that the NJDC PAC made excessive contributions. Specifically these are: Ethridge for Congress, Hancock for Congress, McCarthy for Congress, Cleland for Senate and Durbin for Senate. We have made repeated attempts to assure that no further candidates would be receiving such letters. However, the Hancock for Congress Committee received such letter as recently as two weeks ago. We would greatly appreciate it if you would take the necessary steps to ensure that Reports Analysis is aware that NJDC PAC has filed its FEC Form 1M and that the Committee has been qualified to make such contributions since August 16, 1996.

We thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation.
