
Dear Mr. Koeppe:

I am writing to inform the Federal Election Commission (the "FEC") that the Nassau Democratic County Committee (the "Nassau Democratic Party") is withdrawing the Statement of Organization dated September 18, 2000 that was voluntarily filed with the FEC because the Nassau Democratic Party is not a political committee as defined under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, (the "Act") and FEC Regulations.

The Nassau Democratic Party has not reached the registration thresholds set forth in the Commission regulations at 11 C.F.R. §100.5(c) that trigger registration and reporting requirements for local party organizations that become federal political committees. Specifically, during the calendar year 2000 the Nassau Democrats have received zero federal contributions, made zero federal expenditures, and have not spent more than \$5,000 on exempt party activities. Accordingly, the Nassau Democratic Party is not a political committee under the Act and, therefore, it is not required to register with the FEC.
