This letter is to respond to our conversation of January 20, 2010 regarding the Concerned Women for America Legislative Action Committee Political Action Committee's 30 Day Post-Special Report (10/15/09-11/23/09).

CWALAC PAC listed a total of \$5,941.87 in payments to its connected organization for "Fundraising, Rent, Misc."

This payment was for PAC solicitation expenses; while CWALAC could permissibly pay for these administrative and solicitation expenses pursuant to 11 CFR 114.1(b) and 11 CFR 114.5(b), in this case, CWALAC PAC chose to pay for these expenses with federal funds. Therefore, CWALAC PAC has amended its 30 Day Post-Special Report for 10/15/09-11/23/09 to provide more detail about the purpose of the payment of \$5,941.87 on Line 21, which was for PAC solicitation expenses. The payment of these expenses were not made in advance of the services rendered; however, this is not required because CWALAC, the connected organization, is permitted to pay these expenses in the first instance. See 11 CFR 114.1(b) and 11 CFR 114.5(b).
