Dear Mr. Patrick:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-The supporting schedule for loans and lines of credit from lending institutions (Schedule C-1) must disclose the name and address of the lender, amount, interest rate, date incurred, date due, the treasurer's signature, and the signature of an authorized representative of the lending institution. In addition, it may be necessary to provide information regarding restructured loans, draws on lines of credit, secondary sources of repayment, traditional collateral, future receipts as collateral and other means of obtaining loans according to your activity. Please amend Schedule C-1 and any other affected schedules to provide the loan agreement for your line of credit. 11 CFR §§100.7(b)(11) and 100.8(b)(12)

-Schedule C-1 discloses \$175,000 in total draws made on your new line of credit; however, Schedule C discloses the full \$200,000 line of credit in the Original Amount of Loan box. Schedule C should reflect only the funds actually received by your committee which you are now obligated to repay. FEC calculations disclose this figure to be \$175,000. Please amend your report to clarify this figure.


-Please clarify all expenditures made for media buy on Schedule H4. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedule B or F supporting Line 23 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §104.3(b)

-Please clarify all expenditures for "voter registration" and "get-out-the-vote". In addition, if any of the voter registration or get-out-the-vote activities referenced House or Senate candidates, they should be allocated accordingly, unless merely incidental to the overall activity. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of federal candidates, they should be reported on Schedule B or F for Line 23 or 25 of the Detailed Summary Page, as appropriate.

-Please identify the name and address of the original payee for the in-kind contribution(s) disclosed on Schedule B for Line 23.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
