On August 26, 1998, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your September 11, 1998 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Schedule D discloses the outstanding balance at the close of the period for the debt owed to Sandra L. Pack, CPA, LLC to be \$5,355.80. FEC calculations disclose this amount to be \$3,355.80. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

-Please provide further clarification regarding the expenditures made for fundraising video production on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedule B or E supporting Line 23 or 24 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR § 104.3(b) and 106.1.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
