
Dear Mr. Gibson:


Your November 15, 1999 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

Please be advised that any contributor information received after the contributions are reported must be filed on a memo Schedule(s) A with your next report, or on an amended report(s), for the period in which the contributions were originally disclosed

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.



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
