This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 item(s):

1. The beginning cash balance of this report does not equal the ending balance of your Year End Report (12/1/13-12/31/13). Please correct this discrepancy and amend all subsequent report(s) that may be affected by the correction. (2 U.S.C. § 434)(b)(1))
2. Line 11(b) of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$46,806 in contributions from political party committees. The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule A, however, indicates the total to be \$0. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy. (11 CFR § 104.3(a) and (b))
3. Please provide a Schedule A for the total amount disclosed on Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. All transfers from affiliates received by your committee must be itemized on Schedule A regardless of the amount. (2 U.S.C. §434(b)(3)(D) and 11 CFR § 104.3(a)(4)(iii))

- Your report discloses certain categories of financial activity that have been reflected on the wrong lines of the Detailed Summary Page. For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, transfers from affiliated committees, including affiliated national party committees, should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule(s) A, supporting Line(s) 12 of the


