Dear Ms. Gardiner:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the notice referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:


-Any person, group of persons, or qualified non-profit corporation or organization who makes an electioneering communication must disclose their full name and address (and employer and occupation if necessary), as well as the date of public distribution and title of the electioneering communication. The full name, address, employer and occupation of the Custodian of Records must also be disclosed. (11 CFR §104.20(c)) Your FEC Form 9 received August 17, 2004 fails to include the date of public distribution and the communication title. Please amend your filing to include the missing information.

-On Line 11 of your filing, you have failed to disclose the person or persons sharing or exercising control of the making of the disbursement/obligation for the electioneering communication. You must provide the name, address, employer, and occupation of each person sharing or exercising control. (11 CFR §104.20(c)(2)) Please amend your filing to include the missing information.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
