Response to FEC Letter of November 27, 2012 requesting additional information for the June Monthly Report (05/01/2012 - 05/31/2012)

Item 1 - First names in lieu of initials have been obtained for 2 of the 4 donors, and is reflected in the Amended Report which is also being submitted. Best efforts have been used to obtain missing information. RPV uses the following procedures for obtaining required donor information:

- 1 - RPV requests the information in all solicitation materials and includes an appropriate statement of law as set forth in 11CFR104.7(b)(1).
- 2 - Within 30 days of receiving a contribution that exceeds the \$200 threshold, but for which all required information is not provided, an attempt is made to contact the contributor by telephone or email, if these are on file.
- 3 - If this attempt does not yield the missing information, a letter is promptly mailed to the contributor requesting the information. There is no attempt to make an additional solicitation.
- 4 - RPV uses whatever other sources are available such as VPAP and web searches. When information is obtained, the donor database is updated and information reported.

Item 2 - The omitted aggregate boxes for year-to-date totals for disclosed contributions from individuals have been checked, and the missing information is now displayed. No individuals have exceeded their limit.

Item 3 - Funds received from the National Republican Senatorial Committee and the Republican National Committee include a letter stating that none of the funds transferred are earmarked for any particular program or purpose. The Coal Industry yard signs did not mention any candidates, but was intended as a show of support for coal industries in that location.

Item 4 - The Discover card payment of \$107.52 on 5/9/12 to the Sheraton Hotel was for employee lodging for a site visit. It was not made on behalf of, or for the benefit of any specifically identified Federal candidate.
