Your letter dated January 16, 2009 brought to our attention the fact that certain contributions made by Sandler, Travis and Rosenberg P.A. Political Action Committee ("STARPAC") may have exceeded the limits set forth in 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a). We investigated the contributions in questions and upon further review, it appears that STARPAC did, in fact, exceed the applicable contribution limits.

Pursuant to our conversation, I have electronically filed the FEC form 99 and have attached copies of the letters sent to the recipient committees requesting refunds for amounts given in excess of the federal limits as set forth below.






