This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following $\underline{1}$ item(s):

- Your amended report discloses additional disbursements totaling \$14,000 on Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page that were not disclosed on your original report. The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating, "Due to an inadvertent administrative error, the following contributions, each for \$2,000 on July 12, 2010,, were omitted from the original filling: Cummings for Congress, Doyle for Congress, Hoosiers for Hill, Committee to Elect Chris Murphy, Maloney for Congress, Matsui for Congress, and Matheson for Congress." Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this matter, your clarification and any additional clarification you may have will be taken into consideration. 11 CFR §104.3

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. If you should have any
