Dear Ms. McBride:

In response to your letter of October 18, 1995, we are providing the following information:

- Attached are copies of two solicitations sent to contributors by the NRSC in this cycle. In compliance with 11 CFR 104.7(b), these and all of our solicitations include the statement:

"Federal law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year."

Amendments to Line 11(a)(i) of the February monthly report were filed with our March, April, May, June, July, August and September reports based on responses to our second request for information. A copy of one of our "best efforts" request letters is also attached.

The NRSC continues to comply with the requirements of 11 CFR 104.7(b).

- In accordance with 11 CFR 103.3(b), the NRSC has transferred \$4,000.00 of a \$5,000.00 contribution from Friends of Ned Regan into our non-federal account. The NRSC has retained \$1,000.00 of this contribution in our federal account, and confirmed that the contributor had sufficient funds subject to the prohibitions and limitations of the Act to make such contribution. 11 CFR 102.5(b)(1)(ii). A letter from Friends of Ned Regan and a copy of the transfer check are attached.
- The discrepancies concerning unitemized contributions were caused by a one-time conversion tape issue which we have now resolved with our vendor. The NRSC's best efforts amendments incorrectly included in several contributors' year-to-date totals contributions that they made outside the reporting period of the amendment but before the tape was run to create the amendment. The total of the original Line 11a(i) is correct and does not need to be amended.

-- We have amended our February report (1/1/95-1/31/95) to correctly report the \$14,000.00 partial refund from the Republican State Committee of Missouri on Line 25. The original expense of \$28,076.00 was a coordinated general election expenditure paid to the Missouri Republican Party on behalf of candidate John Ashcroft, reported on Line 25 in the December 1994 report (11/1/94-11/30/94) (copy attached).

In addition, during our research we discovered another incorrectly reported refund of coordinated expenditure to the U.S. Postal Service on behalf of John Ashcroft. We have amended our January report (11/29/94-12/31/94) to correctly report this refund on Line 25.




