PeacePAC submitting an amendment today to the 2001 Year End Report covering the period July 1 - December 31, 2001. This amendment corrects minor itemization and other small data mistakes in the electronic file and also responds to ambiguous issues recently raised by the Commission's Reports Analysis Division.

Schedule B, Line 23 discloses the name, office, state, and district of each federal candidate PeacePAC has made a contribution to. The Committee uses the FEC's electronic filing software and has corrected the itemization of contributions under \$200 that were automatically "unitemized" by the software.

The Committee reports earmarked contributions in accordance with the Commission's regulations at 11 CFR Sec. 110.6(c)(1). All earmarked contributions to federal candidates are itemized on Schedule A, Line 11(a) and on Schedule B, Line 23, in a clear manner. Each piece of information required by these regulations is disclosed. The Committee has reviewed the example provided by the analyst and notes that the schedules pictured (on outdated forms) are not necessarily supported by the regulations or the text below the picture that delineates the information to be reported. The Committee is reviewing alternative ways to format earmarked contributions in the future to more closely meet the Reports Analysis Division's internal guidelines and to continue to present all of the information required by the regulations within the framework of the electronic filing parameters.

The Committee only itemizes contributions to PeacePAC from contributors whose calendar year aggregates exceed \$200. The total of all contributions aggregating \$200 or less are reported on detail summary page 3, Line 11(a)(ii). Earmarked contributions to federal candidates are itemized, regardless of amount, as required by Commission regulations on reporting earmarks referenced above. Each earmarked contribution is clearly identified on Schedule A.
