Dear Mr. Castle:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Schedule C of your report discloses an outstanding loan from Merrill Lynch reported with an interest rate of P+1.5%. Schedule D of your report discloses interest debt owed to the candidate. If the interest payment(s) on the loan are being made by the candidate, they should be report as in-kind contributions on Schedules A and B. Please note: non-payment of interest on the loan may be considered a prohibited contribution by the lending institution.

-A review of your itemized receipts indicates a discrepancy in your aggregate election cycle-to-date totals. The reported aggregate totals on your report should include all contributions from an individual or committee given in the election cycle. Please review your procedures for compliance with this requirement and amend your report(s) as necessary. (11 CFR §104.3(a)(3))

A response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
