

Dear Mr. Pope,

As your letter sent on February 5, 2008 requests, Friends of Connie Mack follow's the FEC's requirements for "Best Efforts."

First, the committee's original solicitation always includes a clear and obvious request for the contributor information and informs the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information.

Secondly, within 30 days of the receipt of the contribution, the committee makes one follow-up, effort by mail or e-mail to obtain this information if it is not provided. We request the missing information without soliciting a contribution. Our notice informs the contributor of the federal requirements for reporting such information, and the committee includes a pre-addressed return envelope with every request sent by mail. Written records are kept documenting such requests.

Third, we periodically review other sources for records of the donors informations.

Since our last report we have received additional information from contributors. It is included in this amended January 31, 2008 report (Year End 2007).
