Please note that on September 28, 1994 I called the FEC at 800-424-9530 and spoke to Erica [last name not known to me]. I told her that BOSPAC had received contributions from several trusts and asked her if the trusts could make the referenced contributions and if so, whether the trusts would be properly reported as the contributor. Erica told me the trusts could make the contributions and that as legal entities, the trusts were the properly reportable source of the funds. We could locate no provision of FELA or 11 CFR which required further reporting for trust contributions. The information on the BOSPAC report regarding the trust contributions is complete.
