In response to your Request for Information dated 8/14/2012 regarding the Amended April Monthly report (03/01/2010 - 03/31/2012) received on 03/22/2012, apparent excessive contributions were made due to an error in election designation. Therefore, since the conditions for re-designation were not met within the allotted 60 days of the treasurer's receipt, ACPAC must obtain a refund of the excessive amount.

In reference to the contribution to Bachman for Congress on 03/26/2010, a refund of \$10,000 was reported on the 2010 September Monthly Report/Amended 2010 September Monthly Report submitted to the FEC on 03/22/2012.

In closing, I wish to reassert my intention, as recently appointed Treasurer, to work with you to provide any additional information that may be useful to the Federal Election Commission in bringing final resolution to all these matters and to be confident that ACPAC is operated in full compliance with election law.
