This form 99 submission is in response to the Commission's letter dated October 27, 2006. The loan as reported to Terry Holly is a debt owed to the Democratic Party. The 'loan' is in lieu of payment ordinarily made to the Committee for Ballot Fees, as prescribed by Georgia State Law for ballot access. These fees are collected by the Committee from all candidates appearing on the primary ballot in the state of Georgia. A portion of the fees paid to the Party are forwarded to the Georgia Secretary of State, with the balance being retained by the Committee. Although there were never any transfers of actual funds to Terry Holly for his ballot fees, the payment of his ballot fees to the Georgia Secretary of State were not considered an in-kind contribution to his campaign. The Committee fully intends to collect the entire amount of Terry Holly's ballot fees.
