Dear Mr. Furman:

This letter is in response to your request for additional information, dated December 3, 2014.

1. Your letter indicates that the Committee disclosed one or more contributions that appear to exceed the limits set forth in the act. The Committee is aware of the contribution limits. In the case of an individual, if the contribution cannot be presumptively reattributed to a spouse or redesignated to a subsequent election, the Committee either sends a verified reattribution letter or refunds the excessive portion within 60 days of receipt. The Committee sends all presumptive reattribution and redesignation letters within 30 days of receipt and always gives the donor the option of making a change or requesting a refund. When the Committee receives contributions from other political committees that cause an excessive total, the Committee contacts the other political committee and requests a verified redesignation. If this is not received, the Committee issues a refund. The following is a response to each contributor listed in you letter:

Kenneth Abramowitz-refunded \$1300 on 12/14/14. This will be disclosed on the Year-End FEC Report.

Will Davis-\$2600 was charged back via credit card on 10/17/14. This was disclosed on the Post General FEC report.

Robert Diener- refunded \$1800 on 12/14/14. This will be disclosed on the Year-End FEC Report.

IPHFHA, Inc. PAC- refunded \$2500 on 12/6/14. This will be disclosed on the Year-End FEC Report.


National Venture Capital Association PAC- refunded \$3000 on 12/6/14. This will be disclosed on the Year-End FEC Report.






