Dear Mr. Stoetzer:

This letter is in response to your Request for Additional Information (RAI), dated April 17, 2013, asking for additional information pertaining to General election debt retirement contributions made by the AT&T Federal PAC to Luke Messer for Congress and Friends of Trey Radel, Inc. Typically, debt retirement contributions are made by the AT&T Federal PAC in response to a specific request from a candidates committee, and, prior to making any debt retirement contributions, the AT&T Federal PAC reviews the committees information that is publicly filed with the Federal Election Commission to confirm the committee has outstanding debt. At the time these debt retirement contributions were made, the AT&T Federal PAC conducted this due diligence process.

The contribution to Friends of Trey Radel, Inc. was designated for 2012 General election debt retirement; however, when we contacted the candidate committee after receiving your correspondence, we were informed that they only had outstanding 2012 Primary debt. The AT&T Federal PAC received a refund from Friends of Trey Radel, Inc. on 4/29/13, which will be reported in our May 20 Monthly filing with the FEC.

Subsequent to receipt of your correspondence, the AT&T Federal PAC was informed by the Luke Messer for Congress committee that due to a miscalculation on their part, they did not have sufficient 2012 General election debt. The AT&T Federal PAC received a refund from Luke Messer for Congress on 5/06/13, which will be reported in our June 20 Monthly filing with the FEC.
