



Lily Eskelsen is the Democratic candidate for Congress in Utah's Second Congressional District. She was elected to the House of Representatives in 1994. She served on the House Education Committee and the House Small Business Committee. She was re-elected in 1996. She is currently serving on the House Education Committee and the House Small Business Committee.

# 2nd CD Race is "Too Close To Call"

According to a new poll by Dan Jones and Associates, Merrill Cook's own campaign pollster, the 2nd Congressional District race is too close to call. The poll, conducted on Sunday, October 4, 1998, shows that only one of the four congressional contests in the 2nd District race between Rep. Merrill Cook and Lily Eskelsen is too close to call. Among all adults polled in the 2nd Congressional District, the results are:

2nd CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT - ALL ADULTS (includes non-registered voters)	
Merrill Cook (R)	44%
Lily Eskelsen (D)	37%
Ken Lamm (IF)	6%
Other / Don't Know	13%

However, Dan Jones found that the race has tightened since the last newspaper survey conducted in June. Jones also found that among adults who said they are registered to vote, Cook's lead drops very close:

2nd CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT - REGISTERED VOTERS ONLY	
Merrill Cook (R)	43%
Lily Eskelsen (D)	41%
Other / Don't Know	16%

**Says Dan Jones, Merrill Cook's own pollster, "The race is too close to call."**

# Lily Eskelsen for Congress Update

## Lily Eskelsen

is the Democratic candidate for Congress in Utah's Second Congressional District, the seat currently held by Independent-named-Republican first-term Rep. Merrill Cook. A genuine "swing" district, the 2<sup>nd</sup> CD seat was formerly held by popular Democrat Kass Stephens (1993-1995) and Wayne Owens (1987-1993). Eskelsen is a 6<sup>th</sup> grade teacher in Salt Lake City, Utah; past-President of the Utah Education Association, and now serves on the Executive Committee of the National Education Association.

# 42% - 41%

*The Salt Lake Tribune* reported October 25, 1998 that Lily Eskelsen has taken the lead in Utah's 2nd CD race. "With 10 days of campaigning remaining, incumbent Merrill Cook and challenger Lily Eskelsen are in a dead heat...according to a survey of 453 registered voters this past week. Eskelsen, a Democrat, was preferred by 42 percent of the respondents in the October 19 - 20 poll, while Republican Cook, who is seeking a second term, was the choice of 41 percent. Libertarian Brian Swim received 4 percent, and 13 percent remain undecided."

"The canvass also found that President Clinton's affair with Monica Lewinsky, the Starr report and impeachment proceedings apparently have not dimmed Utahns' desire to vote. Only 3 percent said the controversy has made them less likely to vote, while one in every four indicated he or she was more likely to vote because of the events."

"Female respondents were slightly more inclined to vote for Eskelsen and were a bit more inclined to vote next month because of events surrounding Clinton."

"The survey was conducted by Valley Research, *The Tribune's* independent pollster, and carries a margin of error of plus or minus 4.7 percent. Valley Research does not conduct surveys for any political candidates."
