Dear Ms. Kang:

This letter is in response to your request for additional information regarding the above-mentioned report. An itemization of the questions raised follows:

Regarding our joint fundraising activity, as required we itemized the contribution of each contributor that exceeded the \$200 threshold and provided the amount of unitemized contributions received during the reporting period. The \$493.67 entry found on Schedule A line 12 represents the net received by the Party during the reporting period. Some of the contributions did not exceed the threshold even when aggregated - those contributions are represented in unitemized total. No further disclosure is needed.

On Schedule H2 the allocation ratio for JJ02 was revised during the reporting period because even though the event was held on March 7, 2002 we had expenses for the event that were paid during the previous reporting period. Since we had expenses but had not yet received the contributions associated with the event JJ02, we had to make an educated guess as to the fundraising ratio. Once the contributions were received we revised the allocation ratio accordingly. No excessive

non-federal transfers were made.

On Schedule H4 page 145 of 192, you will find an example of the memo entry used to show the original vendor from which we have purchased an item using a credit card. Per your instructions in a request for additional information dated January 3, 2000, we have included memo entries if "payments to the vendors have exceeded \$200". (The RFAI referenced is dated 1/3/200 is for our 2000 October Quarterly Report.)
