In response to your letter of October 18, 1995, we are providing the following information:


- On July 31, 1995, NRSC transferred \$5,000.00 from our federal account to our non-federal account to resolve the aggregate excessive contribution of the Federal Express PAC. On November 9, 1995, an amendment was filed reporting the transfer.
- Attached are copies of two solicitations sent to contributors by the NRSC in this cycle. In compliance with 11 CFR 104.7(b), these and all of our solicitations include the statement:

"Federal law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year."

Amendments to Line 11(a)(1) of the July monthly report were filed with our August and September reports based on responses to our second request for information. A copy of one of our "best efforts" request letters is also attached.

The NRSC continues to comply with the requirements of 11 CFR 104.7(b).
