Dear Mr. Beckman:

I serve as campaign counsel to the above named committee, and write in response to the request for additional information date May 16, 2109. The request notes that the committee may have failed to timely file one or more required 48 Hour Independent Expenditure Reports.

On October 4, 2018, the committee filed a 48-Hour Report disclosing a number of estimated independent expenditures based on all known information at the time of filing. On the filing, the committee disclosed estimated payments to Million Voter Project Action Fund supporting TJ Cox and Katie Hill, and opposing David Valadao. These estimated payments were for: ?Phone Banking and Walk Program; 10/1/18?10/17/18(Estimate).?

On October 4, 2018, the committee filed a separate 48-Hour Report disclosing estimated independent expenditures supporting Gil Cisneros and opposing Young Kim. These estimates were disclosed as payments to the Orange County Voter Information Project, which was the known vendor at the time the estimate was filed. These estimated payments were for: ?Canvassing: 10/1/18?10/17/18 (Estimate).?

The transactions included on the request for additional information are payments to additional vendors paid as part of the initial estimates disclosed to Million Voter Project Action Fund and Orange County Voter Information Project as part of the phone banking, walk program, and canvassing activities. At the time the initial estimates were filed, not all vendors used in connection with the phone banking, walk program and canvassing activities were known. Instead, the committee disclosed a good-faith estimate of expenditures up-front using Million Voter Project Action Fund and Orange County Voter Information Project as the vendors.

To clarify the public record, the committee will amend the pre-general report to update the descriptions on these expenditures to make clear that the transactions are in-fact ?actual? expenses for the phone banking, walk program and canvassing estimates initially disclosed on 48-Hour Reports filed on October 4, 2018.
