Dear Mr. Maxwell,

On October 17, you forwarded a letter to Deborah Jones, Treasurer [Whirlpool Corporation Political Action Committee (WCPAC)], noting that a contribution to the 2000 reelection campaign of Senator Spencer Abraham appeared to exceed the limits of the Federal Election Commission Act.

After checking our records, and those of Spencer Abraham's reelection committee, we agreed and responded with our letter (dated October 30, 2001) noting our error and our planned corrective action. We also followed-up with a letter to Spencer Abraham's campaign committee requesting a refund to the WCPAC in the amount of \$1000.

Yesterday, December 18, WCPAC received a letter and a check (copies enclosed) from the Spencer Abraham Campaign Committee for the full \$1000.

We will note this refund in our next FEC report.
