Regarding the March Monthly report and in response to the reporting issue raised in the Request for Additional Information dated 03/23/16 referencing a 24-hour notification report filed 02/27/16: the expenditure disclosed as "nationally disseminated" was not targeted to any state or specific group of states and did not reference an election in any state or specific group of states. The expenditure was exclusively related to media placed with the Fox News Network which in turn aired to all of its subscribers nationwide. This media was not placed with affiliate stations which would have allowed the target audience to be measurable. In the interest of full and best disclosure to the public, the committee has disclosed the expenditures in its whole dollar amount and not an arbitrary allocation to various and numerous states which would grossly misrepresent the nature of the expenditure. Following the guidance proposed in the Draft Interpretive Rule on Reporting Nationwide Independent Expenditures in Presidential Primary Elections, the committee has reported the expenditure as nationwide, leaving blank the section where the state would be indicated. As stated in the Draft Interpretive Rule, this reporting ensures that the expenditure has been fully and accurately disclosed to the public. However, if arbitrary allocation was made to remaining states, the \$267,750.00 on 2/26/16 would have been reported as \$4,958.33 for each of these states: Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado, Georgia, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Oklahoma, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Virginia, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Puerto Rico, Hawaii, Idaho, Michigan, Mississippi, District of Columbia (convention), Guam, Florida, Illinois, Missouri, North Carolina, N. Mariana Islands, Ohio, Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Arizona, Utah, North Dakota, Wisconsin, Wyoming, New York, Connecticut, Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Indiana, Nebraska, West Virginia, Kentucky, Oregon, Washington, California, Montana, New Jersey, New Mexico, South Dakota, and District of Columbia (primary).
