Dear Mr. Pablo:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$1,925 in itemized contributions from individuals. The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule A, however, indicates the total to be \$40. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-Please provide a Schedule B to support the entry reported on Line 22 of the Detailed Summary Page. Each transfer-out to an affiliated committee must be itemized on Schedule B regardless of the amount transferred. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(5)(B)(i)


-Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page should only be used to report the federal and non-federal shares of allocable activities. If your committee has only one account, the total operating expenditures (administrative expenses) should be reported on Line 21(b). Please amend your report to confirm the nature of your expenditures and to provide the total on the appropriate line.

-For future reporting purposes, please note that you should provide the appropriate figures for Lines 20 and 31 of the Detailed Summary Page. Since your committee does not report any shared federal/non-federal activity, all of your receipts and disbursements are considered to be federal. Thus, your total receipts and your total federal receipts (Lines 19 and 20) should be the same, just as your total disbursements and total federal disbursements (Lines 30 and 31) should also be the same.

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A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
