Dear Ms. Fleming,

We are in receipt of your letter dated July 2, 2008 regarding our Monthly Report (4/1/08 - 4/30/08)

In response to the first item regarding our procedures for 'best efforts' the Campaign for Working Families includes the request using the following language on all solicitations.

'Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year.'

This is placed in a box with clear spaces to include the information.

When the information is not provided we send a follow-up letter within 30 days. We included a postage-paid return envelope and a letter - see wording below.

'As you may already be aware, federal election law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address, occupation, and employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. I have provided space at the bottom of this letter for you to list your occupation and employer. Please fill out this information and return this letter to us in the enclosed, postage-paid envelope, so that we may be in compliance with federal regulations. We apologize for this inconvenience and thank you again for your assistance in this matter.'

When the information is returned we amend our reports to include the updated information.

In response to the second item we use the wording 'Info Requested - Not Recd' to show that we have requested the information based on the procedures outlined above. The entry identified as 'Federal Government' is the information provided to us by the donor.

Finally, every six months the Campaign for Working Families sends a second follow-up letter to all donors who have given \$200 in the calendar year but who have not provided the occupation and employer information.
