To the extent the previous communication and amendment did not address your concerns please accept this correspondence as a response to the Federal Election Commission's recent request for the above referenced committee to amend its report to include each contributor who made a donation in excess of \$200 to further the independent expenditure(s).? Regrettably my client cannot comply with this request as my client received no contributions of any kind nor in any amount.

As stated in my previous communication and in order to preserve my clients rights, please note that the expenditures, which were reported the the FEC, were expenditures in support of a local state referendum and had nothing to do with supporting or opposing a federal candidate for any office. However, since the expenditures did depict the likeness of a federal candidate, within close proximity to a federal election, my client voluntarily chose to report these expenditures to the Commission and the local state reporting agency. Nothing in the filing of these reports or this response to the Commissions request should be considered a waiver of any of my clients rights, or consent to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
