Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Your amended report fails to disclose disbursements previously disclosed on your October Monthly Report, received 10/20/08. Please be advised that when amending an electronically filed document, you must submit a complete version of the report, rather than just those portions that are being amended. Please resubmit your report to include any omitted activity or provide clarifying information as to why this activity was omitted from this amended report. 11 CFR §104.18(f)
2. Schedule A supporting Line(s) 11(c) of your report discloses a receipt(s) from "Citizens for Sarbanes", "Friends for Gregory Meeks" and "Mike Honda for Congress" which requires further clarification. For example, if this activity represents a transfer of funds, please indicate "transfer" on Schedule A supporting Line 11(c) of your report. If this activity represents a reimbursement for services provided to this committee, please indicate this on Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report. Please amend your report to clarify the type of activity this receipt(s) represents.
3. Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report discloses disbursements totaling \$16,000.00 to "Grove Insight" for "Generic Cmte. Polling". However, your report also indicates that the disbursement was on

behalf of "Darlene Hooley". If a portion or all of these expenditures contained express advocacy as defined under 11 CFR §100.22, this would constitute an in-kind contribution, an independent expenditure or a coordinated expenditure and should be properly disclosed on a Schedule B, E or F supporting Line 23, 24 or 25 as appropriate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1. Please amend your report to properly report this activity or provide additional clarifying information.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
