The following is a list of all of the contributions that you had questions about and an explanation of them or the action taken in response:

- Friends of John Tanner - A letter has been sent to the committee redesignating the check to the 2000 general election. (Copy is attached).
- Jim Humphreys - This check was to be used to reduce the candidate committee's debts incurred during the primary campaign.
- Paul Perry - This check was to be used to reduce the candidate committee's debts incurred during the primary campaign.
- Evergreen Fund - A refund has been issued. Our next filing will reflect the change.
- New Hampshire Democratic Party - A letter has been sent requesting a refund in the amount of \$1250. (Copy is attached).
- AFL-CIO - This contribution was to a non-federal account. Our next filing will reflect the

-Byrum for Congress - A letter has been sent requesting a refund in the amount of \$500. (Copy is attached).

-Kent Conrad - This contribution was never made and was inadvertently placed on the report. Our next filing will reflect the change.

-The North Dakota Coordinated Campaign - This was a contribution to the federal account of the North Dakota Democratic Party.

-The Coordinated Campaign Federal Account - This was a contribution to the federal account of the West Virginia Democratic Party.


-The Win 2000 Federal Account - This was a contribution to the federal account of the New Jersey Democratic Party.




