The Ohio Farm Bureau Federation Political Action Committee (C00161265) received a letter dated March 31, 2011 in regards our Year-End Report (1/1/2010 - 12/31/2010)

Item 1 is related to a merger of National City Bank and PNC Bank. The bank name change reflects a recent merger that took place between National City Bank and PNC. National City Bank was the PAC's designated campaign depository until the merger with PNC. Going forward, PNC is the PAC's designated depository. The merger did not affect the PAC's bank account in any way.

Amendments to the Year End Report have been filed in regards Item 2 which was for radio advertising that focused strictly on international trade issues. The advertising did not expressly advocate the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate or candidates and the advertising was not done in coordination with any federal candidate.
