This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

- The Commission notes your submission of FEC Form 9, dated 9/24/08. However, the Form 9 was filed after the date of public disclosure on 9/19/08. Any person, group of persons, or qualified non-profit corporation who makes an electioneering communication must notify the Commission no later that 11:59 p.m. Eastern Standard/Daylight Time of the day following the date on which the communication is publicly distributed. (11 CFR § 104.20(b)) Please clarify the circumstances regarding the untimely disclosure of the electioneering communication in question.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. If you should have any
