
-Schedule B of your report (see attached) discloses an apparent excessive contribution(s) made to a state, district, or local party committee. The Act prohibits a multi-candidate committee from making a contribution to a party committee in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year. 2 U.S.C. §441a(a)

The Commission notes the receipt of the refund on your 2004 March Monthly Report. Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning the excessive contribution(s), your prompt action in obtaining a refund will be taken into consideration.

**Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
